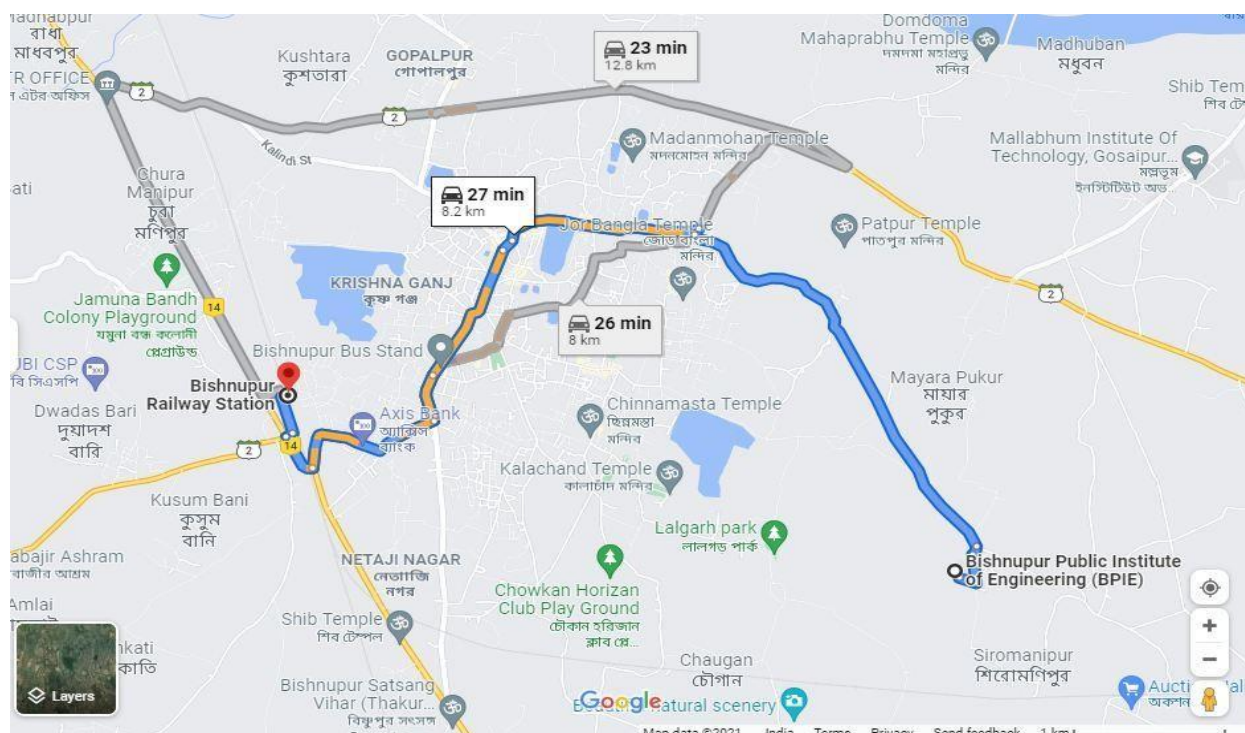
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# Bishnupur Public Institute of Engineering: The Premier Institute for Diploma Engineering Students.

## ETCE DEPT. PROJECT

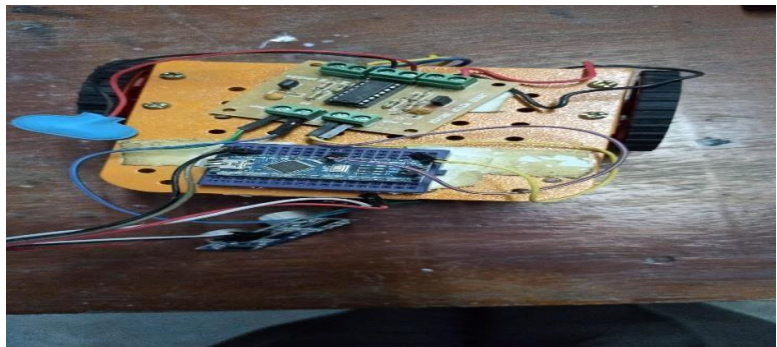
### AUTOMATIC HAND SANITIZER

In this project we propose a novel design of touch-less sanitizer machine to reduce the risk due to contact. The system can sense the proximity with the help of ultrasonic sensor and sends signal to microcontroller. The controller processes the sensor data & actuates the pump and solenoid valve. The sanitizer liquid dispenses through mist nozzle.



### LINE FOLLOWER ROBOT

The Line Follower Robot is a basic robot that follows a specific path indicated by a line (usually a black line on a light coloured surface) having some particular width. This circuit mainly consists of 8051 microcontroller, two IR sensors, motors and motor driver IC (embedded in a module).

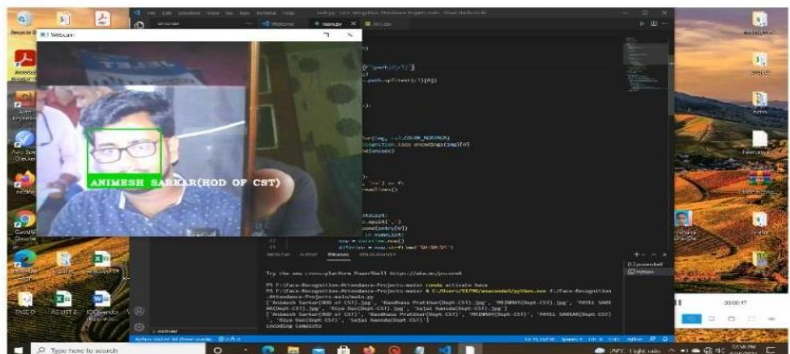
### THE COLOR DETECTION

A color detection algorithm identifies pixels in an image that match a specified color or color range. The color of detected pixels can then be changed to distinguish them from the rest of the image.



### FACE DETECTION TECHNOLOGY

A facial recognition system uses biometrics to map facial features from a photograph or video. It compares the information with a database of known faces to find a match. Facial recognition can help verify a person's identity, but it also raises privacy issues.



## MECHANICAL ENGINEERING DEPT. PROJECT

### WHEEL SPRAY PUMP

Sprayers are fully integrated, mechanical systems and they are composed of various parts and components that work together to achieve the desired effect. A Wheel spray pumps are great tools for quickly and efficiently spraying fertilizers, herbicides, or pesticides on crops and plants.



### HYDRAULIC PRESS

The hydraulic press works by pressing a small amount of force onto the Plunger which presses the working substance. It is easily transportable, commonly used for forging, clinching, moulding, blanking, punching, deep drawing, and metal forming operations.



### HAND OPERATED EARTH EXCAVATOR

It is an earthmoving equipment which is basically light duty hand operated excavator used for moderate range of earthworks including laying foundations, grading soil, removing dirt and rocks, digging trenches, drainage etc.



### 3 WHEEL STAIR CLIMBING TROLLEY

Stair climbing trolleys are specially designed for moving loads up and down stairs. In effect, each wheel is an independent wheel and at a time two wheels are in operating condition. Three wheels combine together to form a larger wheel that assists to move heavy objects on stairs.



### LIFTING BRIDGE

Lift bridges use a system of counterweights and cables to move an interior lift span section that remains horizontal as it is raised up and down like an elevator, allowing river traffic to pass beneath the structure. Throughout its upward swing to provide clearance for boat traffic.

Weir:- An impervious barrier which constructed across a river to raise the water level on the upstream side.

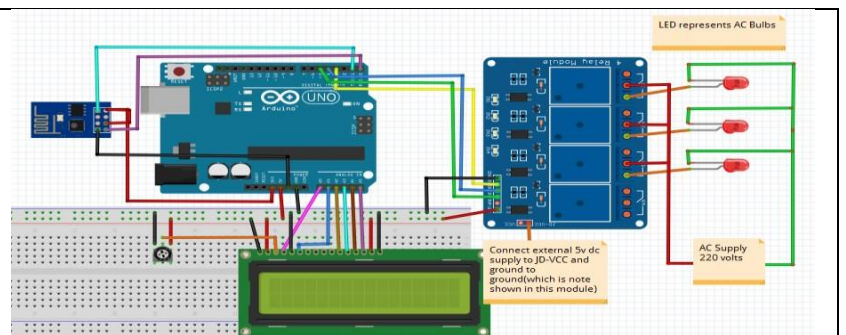
Barrage:- it involve adjustable gates installed over dam to maintain the water surface at different level at different time. The water level is adjusted by opening the valve or gate

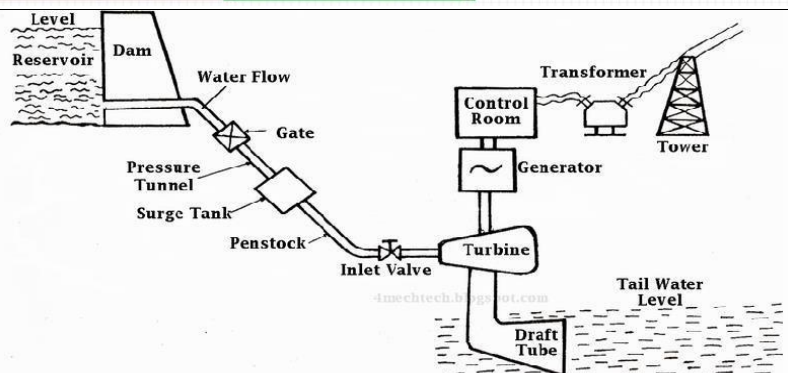

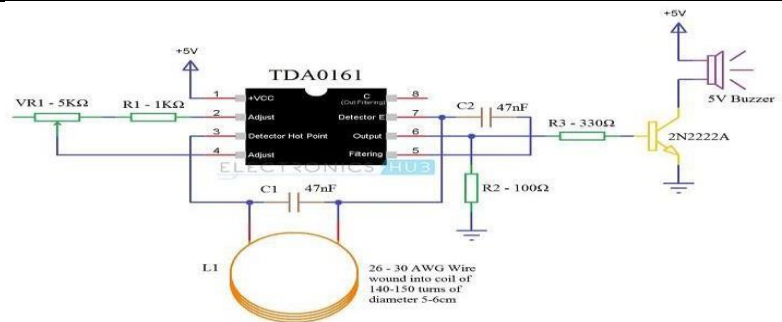

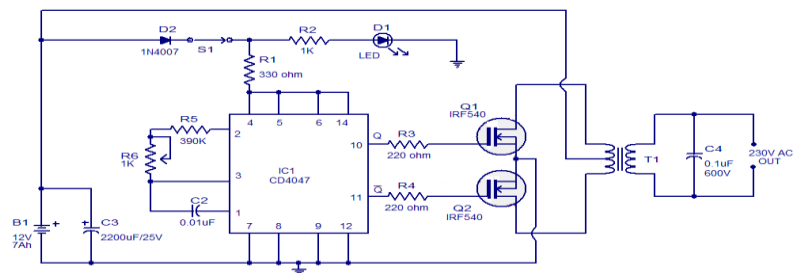
## PCB of Clap Switch Circuit

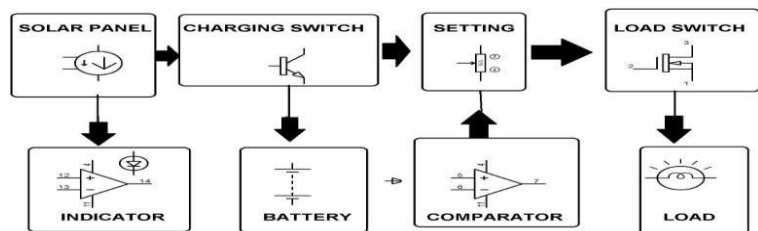

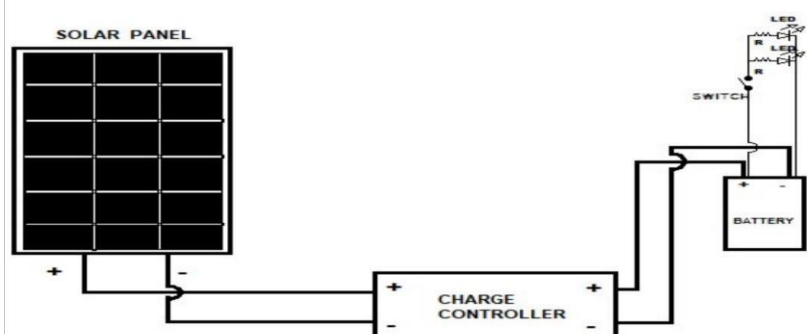

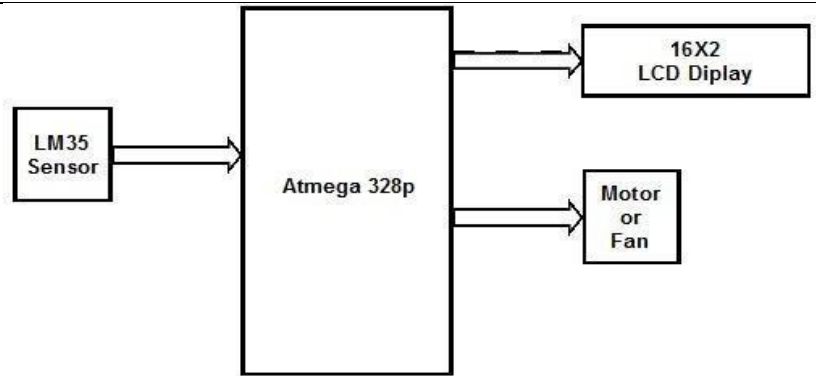

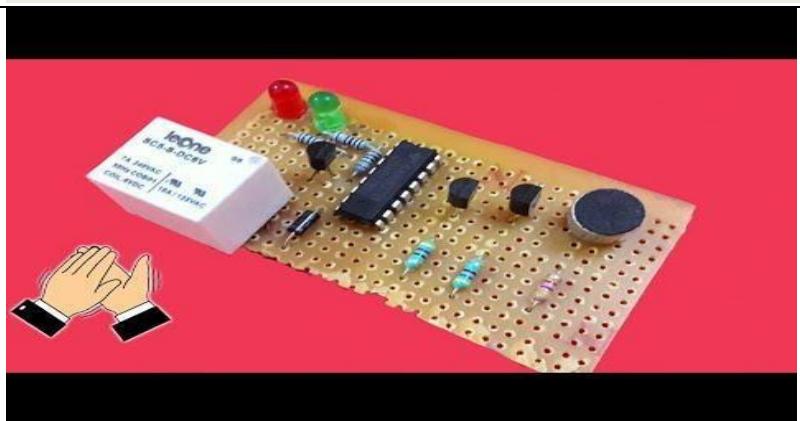


## LIGHTING LOAD CONTROL USING GSM SYSTEM

23. No teacher shall prepare or publish any text book or keys or assist directly or indirectly in their preparation, or use such publications without obtaining prior approval of the BISHNUPUR PUBLIC EDUCATION INSTITUTE (A REGISTERED SOCIETY UNDER SOCIETY REGISTRATION ACT ) .
24. No teacher shall engage himself/herself as a selling agent or canvasser for any publishing firm/trader.
25. No teacher shall apply for an assignment or job outside the BISHNUPUR PUBLIC EDUCATION INSTITUTE (A REGISTERED SOCIETY UNDER SOCIETY REGISTRATION ACT ).directly. He/ She shall invariably forward his/her application through proper channel.
26. No teacher shall present his/her grievances, if any, except through proper channel, nor will he/she canvass for any non-official or outside influence or support in respect of any matter pertaining to his/her service in the BISHNUPUR PUBLIC EDUCATION INSTITUTE (A REGISTERED SOCIETY UNDER SOCIETY REGISTRATION ACT ) .
27. Every teacher shall consider BISHNUPUR PUBLIC EDUCATION INSTITUTE (A REGISTERED SOCIETY UNDER SOCIETY REGISTRATION ACT ) property and funds as if placed In trust with him/her and shall exercise the same with prudence and care as he/she would do in respect of his /her own property or funds.
28. No teacher shall accept or permit any member of his/her family or any other person acting on his/her behalf to accept any gift from any pupil, parent or any person with whom he/she has come into contact by virtue of his/her position in the BISHNUPUR PUBLIC EDUCATION INSTITUTE (A REGISTERED SOCIETY UNDER SOCIETY REGISTRATION ACT ) except as provided under Rule13 of the CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964.
29. No teacher shall, except with the previous sanction of the BISHNUPUR PUBLIC EDUCATION INSTITUTE (A REGISTERED SOCIETY UNDER SOCIETY REGISTRATION ACT ), give any talk on the radio, publish any statement or document either in his/her own name or anonymously, pseudonymously or in the name of any other person, which has the effect of an adverse criticism of any current or recent policy or action of the Central Government or a State Government, or which is capable of embarrassing the relations between the Central Government and a State Government or between the Central Government and the Government of any foreign State,
31. No teacher shall, except with the previous sanction of the competent authority, ask for or accept contribution or other collections in cash or in kind in pursuance of any object, whatsoever.

৬. ছাত্রছাত্রীরা যাতে সক্রিয় রাজনীতিতে অংশ না নেয় - এ ব্যাপারে শিক্ষক/শিক্ষিকারা সদা সতর্ক থাকবেন।
৭. কোনো শিক্ষক/শিক্ষিকা আইনসভা/মন্ত্রিসভার সদস্য হতে পারবেন না। নির্বাচনে অংশগ্রহণের ক্ষেত্রে তাঁকে সর্বাগ্রে তাঁর কর্মক্ষেত্রে ইস্তফা দিতে হবে।
৮. শিক্ষক/শিক্ষিকাদের বিভিন্ন সামাজিক কুপ্রথা ও বদভ্যাসের বিরুদ্ধাচরণ করা উচিত। একইসাথে ছাত্রছাত্রীদের মধ্যে সমাজসেবা ও সহযোগিতার মনোভাব গড়ে তুলতে হবে।

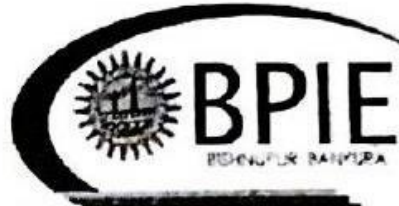

- ১। আমাদের শিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠানটি সহশিক্ষামূলক প্রতিষ্ঠান। ছাত্রী নিবাস ছাত্রাবাস থেকে সম্পূর্ণ পৃথক। আবাসিকদের ছাত্রাবাসে / ছাত্রীনিবাসে অন্তত এক বছর থাকা আবশ্যিক। শিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠানে ও হোস্টেলে শৃঙ্খলা বজায় রাখা শিক্ষার্থীদের পবিত্র কর্তব্য। শিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠানের পরিপন্থী বা সম্মান হানিকর কোন আচরণ থেকে আমাদের সতর্ক থাকতে হবে।
- ২। ভারত সরকারের আইন অনুযায়ী র‍্যাগিং কঠোরভাবে নিষিদ্ধ ও দণ্ডনীয়। আইনের বিশেষ ধারায় সম্পূর্ণভাবে দণ্ডনীয় অপরাধ। কলেজে অ্যান্টি র‍্যাগিং কমিটির বিচার চূড়ান্ত। প্রয়োজনে অপরাধী ছাত্র বা ছাত্রীকে বহিষ্কার ও অন্যথায় দণ্ড দেওয়া হতে পারে।
- ৩। ছাত্র-ছাত্রীদের অভিভাবকরা যারা ছবি সহ নাম পঠিয়াছেন কেবলমাত্র তাঁরাই লবিতে / প্রতিষ্ঠানে ছাত্র - ছাত্রীদের সঙ্গে সাক্ষাৎ করতে পারবেন।
- ৪। নির্দিষ্ট দিনে ও নির্দিষ্ট সময়ে অভিভাবকদের আসার জন্য ছাত্র - ছাত্রীরা বাড়ীতে বলে রাখবে।
- ৫। ছাত্রীদের সালোয়ার কামিজ পরিহিত অবস্থায় লবিতে ও ক্যান্টিনে আসা আবশ্যিক। ছাত্রদের ফুলপ্যান্ট পরিহিত অবস্থায় ক্যান্টিনে / লবিতে আসা আবশ্যিক।
- ৬। হোস্টেলে ইলেকট্রনিক্স দ্রব্য (যথা- টেপ রেকর্ডার, সি. ডি., ওয়াকম্যান ইত্যাদি) রাখা ও ব্যবহার করা অপরাধ বলে গণ্য হবে।
- ৭। রাত্রি জাগরণ করে তাস, পাশা বা দাবা খেলা নিষিদ্ধ। সন্ধ্যা ৬ (ছয়) টার মধ্যে হোস্টেলে ফিরতে হবে কারণ ঐ সময়ে গেট বন্ধ হবে।
- ৮। Room-এ কোন অশোভন পোস্টার দেওয়াল লিখন, ক্যালিগ্রাফ ইত্যাদি টাঙানো যাবে না।
- ৯। ধূমপান বা মাদক দ্রব্য রাখা ও ব্যবহার সম্পর্কে অভিযোগ এলে বা তদন্তে প্রমাণিত হলে ছাত্র - ছাত্রীকে বহিষ্কার করা হবে।
- ১০। ছাত্রীনিবাসে ছাত্রদের এবং পুরুষ আত্মীয় স্বজনদের প্রবেশ নিষিদ্ধ।
- ১১। যদি কারো অসুখে ডাক্তার আনার প্রয়োজন হয় বা হাসপাতালে যাবার প্রয়োজন হয় তাহলে কর্তৃপক্ষ / হোস্টেল সুপারিনটেনডেন্ট ডাক্তার আনা বা হাসপাতালে বা অন্যত্র পাঠানোর ব্যবস্থা করবেন, তখন ছাত্র - ছাত্রীকেই ব্যয় বহন করতে হবে।
- ১২। হোস্টেল সুপার যেমন সময় নির্ধারণ করবেন, সেই মত তাঁর সাথে সাক্ষাৎ করতে হবে। প্রতিদিন শোবার আগে হাজিরা নেওয়া হবে।



- ১৩। ছাত্রাবাসে ও ছাত্রীনিবাসে কে কোন কক্ষে অবস্থান করবে সে বিষয়ে সিদ্ধান্ত গ্রহণ করার অধিকার সুপারিনটেনডেন্টদের। সকল আবাসিকদের তা মেনে চলতে হবে।
- ১৪। সুপারিনটেনডেন্টের অনুমতি ছাড়া কোন বহিরাগত ব্যক্তির হোস্টেলে প্রবেশ নিষিদ্ধ।
- ১৫। হোস্টেল সুপারের অগোচরে কোন ব্যক্তিকে হোস্টেলে রাখা, ভোজনকক্ষে নিয়ে গিয়ে খাওয়ানো অপরাধ বলে গণ্য হবে। কারও আত্মীয় স্বজনের থাকার প্রয়োজন দেখা দিলে তত্ত্বাবধায়কের অনুমতি নিতে হবে।
- ১৬। কোন অবস্থাতেই কোন ছাত্রী ছাত্রাবাসে প্রবেশ করবে না। অনুরূপে, ছাত্ররাও ছাত্রী নিবাসে প্রবেশ করবে না।
- ১৭। জানালা / দরজায় ছাত্রীরা পর্দা লাগাবে, খোলা চুলে মহিলারা ছাত্রী নিবাসের বাইরে আসতে পারবে না।
- ১৮। খাওয়া শেষ হলে ভোজনকক্ষ ত্যাগ করতে হবে। নচেৎ রান্নাঘরের কর্মীদের কাজের অসুবিধা হবে। রান্নাঘরের তালিকা ছাড়া ব্যক্তিগত রুচি অনুযায়ী বিকল্প কোন খাদ্য সরবরাহ করা যাবে না। ভোজনকক্ষ ছাড়া অন্য কোন স্থানে খাদ্য সরবরাহ করা যাবে না। **Canteen Rules** অনুসরণ করতে হবে।
- ১৯। হোস্টেল ও তার চারদিক পরিষ্কার রাখা সকলের যৌথ দায়িত্ব। পায়খানা, পুস্তাবখানা যথাযথ ব্যবহার করে স্বাস্থ্যপ্রদ পরিবেশ বজায় রাখতে হবে। জানালা দিয়ে থুথু, ময়লা, আবর্জনা বাইরে ফেলা অনুচিত।
- ২০। হোস্টেলে নিয়মিত পড়াশোনা করতে হবে। পড়ার সময় রুমে গোলমাল করা চলবে না।

He further states that the All India Council For Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi vide its Notification no. 37-3/Legal/AICTE/2009 dated 25-03-2009 has taken a very serious view of ragging incidences in educational institutions and the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide its Order dated 16.5.2007 has ordered strict implementation of the rules & regulations for prevention and prohibition of Ragging in Technical Institutions.

The Principal states that the Hon'ble Supreme Court has, inter-alia, mentioned the types of ragging:-

1. Ragging has several aspects with, among others, psychological, social, political, economic, cultural, and academic dimensions.
2. Any act that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of a student should be considered within the academics related aspect of ragging.
3. Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a junior student by senior students should be considered an aspect of ragging for ragging economic dimensions.
4. Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestured, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person can be put in the category of ragging with criminal dimensions.
5. Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, blogs, public insults should be considered within the psychological aspects of ragging.
6. The human rights perspective of ragging involves the injury caused to the fundamental right to human dignity through humiliation heaped on junior students by seniors; often resulting in the extreme step of suicide by the victims.

The Principal states that Anti-Ragging Committee will be the Supervisory and Advisory Committee in preserving a Culture of Ragging Free Environment in the college Campus. The Anti-Ragging Squad- office bearers will work under the Supervision of Anti Ragging Committee and to engage in the works of checking places like Hostels, Buses, Canteens, Classrooms and other places of student congregation. Anti-Ragging Committee will be involved in designing strategies and action plan for curbing the Menace of Ragging in the college by adopting array of activities.

The principal further points out that Anti-Ragging Squad will be working under the Monitoring of Anti Ragging Committee and will seek advice from the Anti-Ragging Committee. The functions of Anti-Ragging Squad will be to keep a vigil and stop the incidences of Ragging, if any, happening / reported in the places of Student aggregation including, Classrooms, Canteens, Buses, Grounds, Hostels etc. The Squad will also educate the students at large by adopting various means about the menace of Ragging and related Punishments there to. A gamut of positive reinforcement activities are adopted by Anti-Ragging Squad for orienting students and moulding their personality for a better cause. They shall work in Consonance and Guidance of Anti Ragging Committee.

After a threadbare discussion, the Anti-Ragging Committee and the Anti-Ragging Squad are formed with the following Members:

The students are hereby advised that they need not hesitate to report to any Member of the Anti-Ragging Committee or Squad any grievances arising due to any kind of misbehavior by a senior student. It is assured that once such an incident is established, severe action will be taken by the authorities against those responsible. All steps are being taken to restrain the seniors from resorting to any acts which may be construed as ragging so that the juniors can move freely in the College campus. Students may feel free to contact any authority of this Polytechnic College in case of any grievance or threat of ragging.

The committee is institutionalized to hear complaints and grievances in relation to incidents of Ragging. Along with that, it is constituted to inquire into the grievance and make recommendations towards the complaints brought in front of it.


The Principal thereafter mentions the actions to be taken against students for indulging and abetting in Ragging in technical institutions:-

1. The punishment to be meted out to the persons indulged in ragging has to be exemplary and justifiably harsh to act as a deterrent against recurrence of such incidents. The students who are found to be indulged in ragging should be debarred from taking admission in any technical institution in India.
2. Every single incident of ragging a First Information Report (FIR) must be filed without exception by the institutional authorities with the local police authorities.
3. Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following.
  - (i) Cancellation of admission
  - (ii) Suspension from attending classes
  - (iii) Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
  - (iv) Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
  - (v) Withholding results
  - (vi) Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
  - (vii) Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
  - (viii) Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters.

## CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

### Best Practices

1. Students are required to maintain regular attendance to be eligible for appearing in the Semester Examinations Conducted by WBSCT&VE&SD. They Should follow the parameters given below:

### Attendance

- i) A student attending at least 75% of the total number of classes\* held shall be allowed to appear at the concerned Semester Examinations subject to fulfillment of other conditions laid down in the regulations.
- ii) A students attending at least 60% but less than 75% of the total number of classes\* held shall be allowed to appear at the concerned Semester Examinations subject to the payment of prescribed condonation fees and fulfillment of other conditions laid down in the regulations.

\*Such attendance will be calculated from the date of commencement of classes or the date of admission, whichever is later.

2. **Students must pass the College Internal Examinations for being sent up for Examination conducted by WBSCT&VE&SD.**
3. Any student **absent in any Internal Examination on medical grounds** must submit before the end of the examination or within three days of this completion a Medical Certificate and a letter to the Principal from the Guardian stating the ground for his/her absence. Such may be considered with sympathy, but it must be understood that **illness innot in itself a valid excuse.**

Sending up, in such cases, will not be granted unless the student's record is very good.

4. Students must wear and display visibly their Identity Cards during College hours inside the campus. In case of lost of Identity Card, a duplicate can be obtained only with the permission of the Principal on payment of a fine.

5. A student failing to clear the fees within the notified date will have to secure re-admission on payment of full fees again with the prior approval of the Principal.
6. Students are expected to treat the member of the staff and their fellow students with courtesy both in and out of the college. There must be no disorderly or offensive conduct at any time.
7. Student must be in their classes and take their seats at the beginning of each period. They must not enter or leave the class room without permission.
8. College property, furniture, library books, etc. must be treated with due care.
9. Rules for the conduct of examinations must be strictly observed.
10. Impersonation at roll-call is a punishable offence.
11. Students are required to check the notice board for important announcement.
12. Students are expected to be formally and decently dressed while in a college.
13. Smoking, chewing tobacco products, playing cards, spitting and loitering are strictly prohibited inside the college & hostel campus and shall invite severe punishment/disciplinary action.

#### **14. Anti-ragging Rules:**

- iv) Bullying /intimidation of others.
- v) Eve-teasing / misbehaviour towards girl- students.
- vi) Damaging / disfiguring Institute property.
- vii) Propagating a strike / disruption of classes.
- viii) Association with banned organizations.
- ix) Propagation communal / caste feeling amongst the students.
- x) Indulging in physical violence in any manner.
- xi) Disobeying lawful orders of the teachers /Principal.
- xii) Bringing unauthorized people / articles inside the Institute.
- xiii) Theft / pilferage of Institute / students' property.
- xiv) Any behaviour unbecoming of a student.
- xv) Indulging in acts of moral turpitude.

**16.**In above acts of misconduct, Principal shall take suitable action as per observation of the disciplinary committee depending on the gravity of the misconduct which may include :

- i) Oral / written warnings to the student and parents.
- ii) Suspension from attending classes / Institute for a specified period.
- iii) Recovery of loss to Institute property.
- iv) Issue of Transfer Certificate.
- v) Expulsion / rustication from the Technical Institute.
